The managing committee of "JOHN 3:16, SOCIETY" Mon has a pleasure in presenting the annual report of the society for the year 2018-19.



ACTIVITIES OF THE YEAR 2018-19

1. Seasonal celebration of the "NEW YEAR" every year, John 3:16, Society Mon conducted a short program on 31 December 2018 in joining hand with the rest of world in celebration of joyous new year. A short speech was given by the Director, (Hamkai) by welcoming the New Year 2019. There was singing and sharing of past experiences of the year 2018 by the audiences, whether the past year was blessed or misfortune. After the program there was refreshment in Office.
2. The first polio phase Mon in collaboration with the Chief Medical officer, office by participating and taking responsibility for the welfare of the children age between 0 – 5 years and covered 1000 children female 654 and male 346, in the month of January 10 in Mon town.

In order to know the hidden talent and the potential of the children the John 3:16, society, initiated painting and drawing competition in office campus with children, 14 females and 11 males, total 25, where the winners were given prizes first, second and third respectively and everyone participated in the competition were presented gifts. The competition lasted for 5 hours. The short program was observed with handing over the prizes by the superintendent of Observation home, Mon and counselor spoke about the gifted talent to explore for the benefit of the future endeavor with the theme: Skills can be made through practice and the talent has to utilize after discovering.

4. The second phase of polio drop was held on 6/02/2018 with the medical department Mon under CMO, covering almost 2000 thousand children which consist of 1200 male and 800 female in Mon town.

As per the observance of "YOGA DAY" international on 21st june every year, the said society also observed this day for the people as it brings a meditation between the soul and the mind in connection with the living God and for the personal healthy maintenance. This is conducted for healthy living and sound mind. The Yoga day begin with a prayer by Co ordinator MR. Tingkai Konyak and brief sharing was give by Mr. P. Angchai konyak (Counsellor Observation Home Mon) followed by the demonstration by Ms. Aphi Wenkangshu (Social worker) and Mr. Anok Konyak (GYM instructor) . the program ended with light refreshment and encouraged everyone to participate every year on the same day.
6. Cleanliness Drive in collaboration with Konjong High School Mon, campaigned on 27th june 2018, under the theme: "BEAT PLASTIC POLLUTION" at Deputy Commissioner Office and Community Hall Mon, Nagaland.

John 3:16 Society, Mon in collaboration with Child Welfare Committee Mon and World Vision India organized one day Seminar on Child Rights and POCSO Act for village level Child Protection committee and ward level Child Protection Committee members and other stakeholders of the district on 24 August 2018 at Longri Memorial hall KBBB Mon town. Awan Konyak, Chairperson of Nagaland State Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NSCPCR) said that, everyone should have the responsibility to ensure that children have atleast the most basic needs to enable them to live safe and normal childhood. As stakeholders the people need to coordinate vertically and horizontally to ensure child well being. Deputy Commissioner Mon K. Thavaseelan (IAS) appreciate the services rendered by the stakeholders working for the wellbeing of the children and further urged them to identify children in distress and help them. The program was chaired by CWC Menber K. Wango Langsym, keynote address was given by program manager, WVI Dr. L. Khobung. District Child Protection Officer Samuel Kapu spoke about Child Rights and Protection and Y. Nockyam Wangnao shared the POCSO Act. Vote of thanks was proposed by David Konyak from World Vision India. A total of 11 wards and the Apex bodies, civil societies, NGOs have attended the program.
8. The said society also attends the Indian Institute Entrepreneurship training held in Gauwahati on 15/01/2018. We could see the positive outcome after participating and training again the staffs for this entrepreneurship purpose for self reliance and independent working.
9. The leadership and wellness training program was held in Dimapur Nagaland, one day on 10/09/2018. With Awon Tangkul, DHP, Imphal. She encourages every individual to take responsibility of a leader to build our society and for the betterment of the future. She further stated that a blind leader cannot lead the people.
